OTHER FEES:

- * Annual administrative fee for one student is \$100, \$125 per family.
- * Annual fundraising contribution fee is \$400 per student (\$600 per family). The contribution amount may be met through a variety of fundraising opportunities.
- * Overnight fieldtrip fees (5th & 6th grades), approximately \$100 per student. Exact fees will be determined and collected in January 2018.

Tuition Reduction Program

Jubilee families have an opportunity to reduce their monthly tuition cost by participating in our Scrip program. Participation in the Scrip program is completely voluntary and is a great way to save on monthly tuition costs. In fact, last year Jubilee families saved a combined \$15,800 on tuition using Scrip.

Here's how it works: Many local and national retail stores, grocery stores, restaurants, and gas stations sell gift cards to our supplier – Great Lakes Scrip – at a discount (there are more than 100 popular stores to choose from). Using Jubilee's Scrip program, Jubilee families then purchase these cards at face value. The profit is split 90/10 . . . 90% is rebated toward the families' tuition for that month, 10% covers minimal shipping and administrative costs. Jubilee families have the opportunity to participate in this program on a weekly basis.

Tuition Assistance Program

In addition to our Scrip program, which is available to all families, Jubilee is committed to assisting qualified families who have a financial need with our Tuition Assistance Program.

Tuition Reduction for Ministers, Military and Public Safety Personnel

Jubilee provides tuition discounts for parents that are active members of the clergy, military or public safety profession. Inquiries may be made to the JCS Treasurer via the school office.
