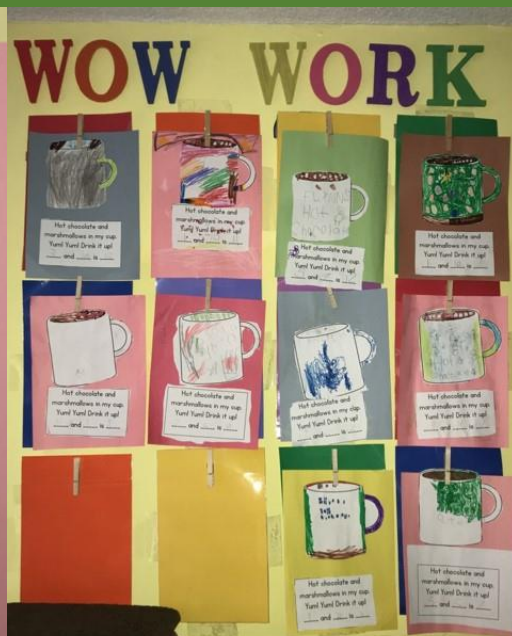
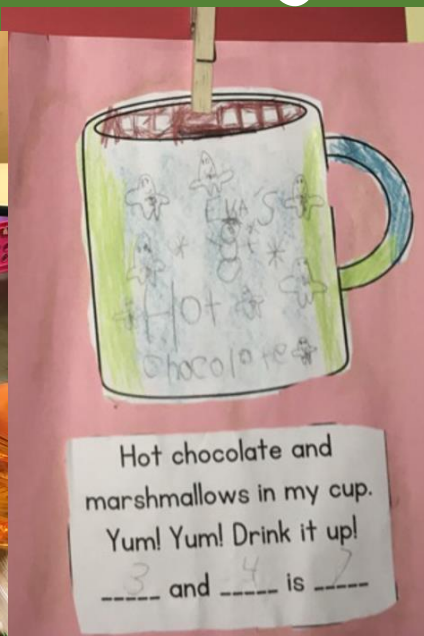




Here's What's Happening at JUBILEE

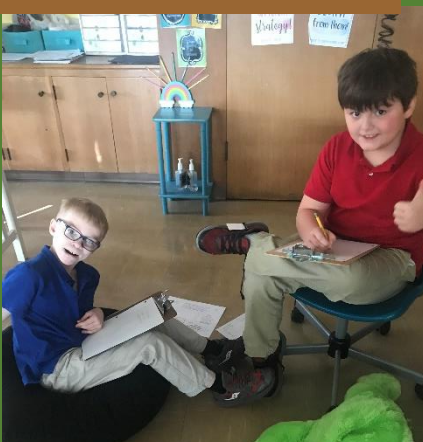
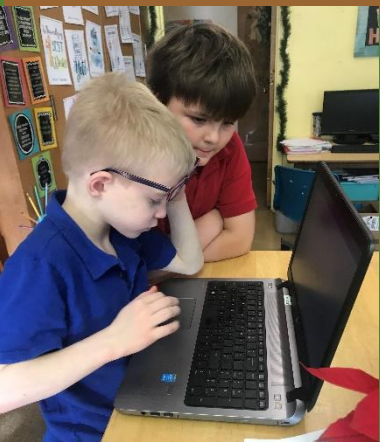
First Grade celebrated National Hot Cocoa Day on Thursday by enjoying some mini marshmallows and a little hot chocolate!
