General Qualifications:

1. Evidence a mature personal Christian faith consistent with the Jubilee Christian School Statement of Faith.
2. Evidence understanding of and a commitment to the distinctive qualities of Christian education as well as the mission of Jubilee Christian School.
3. Possess a bachelor's degree with an emphasis in area of instruction, or a related area.
4. Pennsylvania and/or ACSI Licensure (*certifiable*).
5. Evidence strong organizational, communication, interpersonal, and technological skills.

Primary Responsibilities:

The ideal candidate will:

1. Demonstrate knowledge of subject area/s taught.
2. Demonstrate the ability to integrate other content area into subject matter and collaborate with colleagues and instructional leaders throughout the continuous process.
3. Demonstrate knowledge of development characteristics of age group taught.
4. Effectively utilize the basic elements of instruction (i.e. presenting of information; questioning techniques; responding to learner input and arrangement of learning activities).
5. Demonstrate ability to inspire learning and cultivate relationships with students.
6. Prepare appropriate weekly lesson plans including instructional objectives, planned activities, Biblical integration, assessments and resources.
7. Incorporate classroom technology in order to enhance instruction.
8. Implement effective classroom management and discipline procedures to provide for a positive classroom environment conducive to learning.
9. Regularly review/update department and course curriculum guide/maps to assure the fulfillment of proper instructional priorities and pacing.
10. Model effective teacher/parental partnering through timely communication with parents in support of student learning (posting of grades, conferencing, etc.).

Personal and Professional Profile:

The ideal candidate will:

1. Demonstrate an authentic faith and close personal walk with Jesus Christ: modeling and exemplary Biblical lifestyle and evidencing maturity in the understanding and integration of sound Biblical principles in classroom instruction and personal counseling.
2. Evidence a teachable spirit and general willingness to learn and grow.
3. Evidence strong communication skills, both written and verbal.
4. Demonstrate adeptness at problem solving and conflict resolution.

5. Evidence strong organizational skills and ability to finish tasks in a timely manner.
6. Demonstrate emotional maturity and stability in dealing with the challenges of life and school.
7. Evidence the ability to maintain confidentiality pertaining to school matters.
8. Evidence the ability to work collaboratively within a team.
9. Possess strong computer skills and familiarity with appropriate learning technology.
10. Have the ability to present a positive image of the school to others and to the community.

Instructional Expectations:

The ideal candidate will:

1. Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of class.
2. Submit weekly lesson plans to the Principal.
3. Plan for and lead worship time during our weekly all school chapel (will be on the same day as music class).
4. Attend required in-service trainings and school events (as possible)
5. Plan for and lead students in seasonal concerts (to be determined), all school unit closing program, and the end of the year program (additional compensation).
6. Remain at least 15 minutes at the end of their class.
